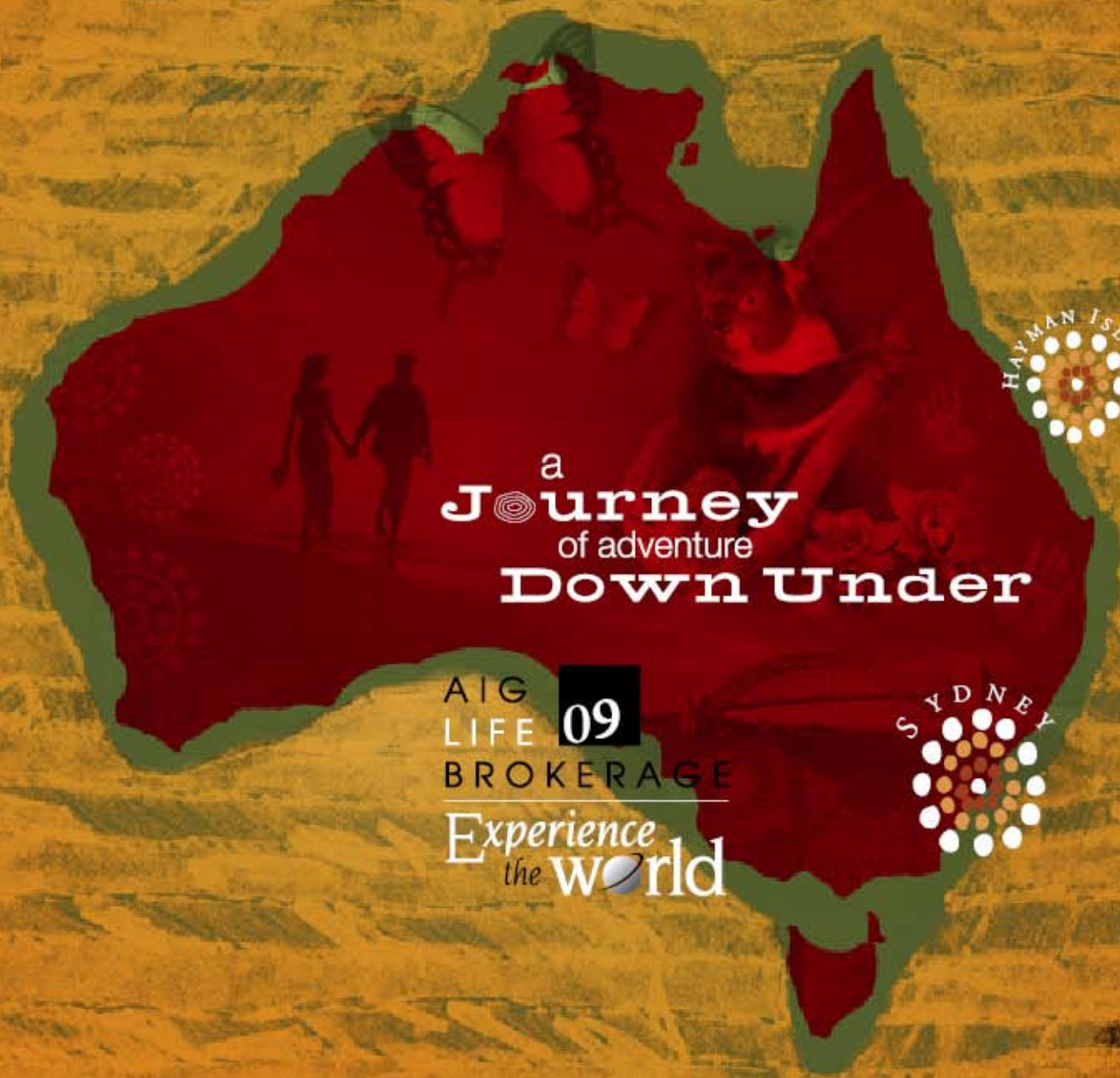

### 2009 AIG Life Brokerage Convention QUALIFICATION RULES

The qualification period is already in progress and many of you are off to a great start. The 18-month qualification period runs from July 1, 2007 through December 31, 2008. The qualification requirement for agency principal and guest is \$1,100,000 of qualifying premium credit as defined below. AIG Life Brokerage will extend invitations to the top 100 eligible agencies who meet or exceed this premium requirement. A minimum of 10 paid cases during the qualification period is required.

**Eligible Participants:** Eligibility is restricted to agencies contracted at the Independent Marketing Organization (IMO) and Brokerage General Agency (BGA) level. Invitations are for agency principals only and may not be transferred to other individuals. We will invite only one principal per agency from the top 100 qualifying agencies. Principal is defined as having ownership in the agency. National Marketing Organizations (NMO), Managing General Agents (MGA), General Agents (GA) and Producers are not eligible. Qualification Period: July 1, 2007 through December 31, 2008.

**Qualification Requirement:** The qualification requirement for the agency principal and guest is \$1,100,000 of qualifying premium credit, as defined below. AIG Life Brokerage will extend invitations to the top 100 eligible agencies who meet or exceed this premium requirement.

**Qualifying Premium Credit:** Qualifying premium credit is earned on products written with American General Life Insurance Company and The United States Life in the City of New York as follows:

- 100% of paid first-year annualized premium credit on term life
- 100% of paid first-year annualized premium credit on whole life, including interest sensitive whole life
- 100% of paid first-year annualized target premium on fixed and indexed universal life, including term conversions to fixed end indexed universal life
- 100% of paid first-year annualized premium credit on supplemental accident & health
- 10% of paid first-year premium in excess of target premium on fixed and indexed universal life
- 10% of paid first-year premium on annuities – single premium, flexible premium, immediate and deferred
- 10% of paid first-year premium on AIG Inheritance Life
- There is no credit on variable universal life

The combined qualifying credit from annuity business may not exceed \$275,000. Credit for split cases will be allocated according to the percentage designated on the application at issue. The personal production of the agency principal counts towards agency production.

**Additional Requirements:** Qualifying business must remain in force throughout the qualification period. Premium lapses occurring during this 18-month period will be deducted from gross premium credits. Attendance is by invitation only. All qualifiers must have an active contract on the date of departure in order to attend. AIG Life Brokerage will be the sole authority in determining qualified participants. All decisions pertaining to attendance eligibility, qualifying premium credit, changes to the program, extension of invitations, and any issues not covered in these guidelines will be determined solely by AIG Life Brokerage.

Attendance is limited to one principal and a spouse/guest per qualifying agency. An agency having more than one principal is required to advise AIG Life Brokerage in writing of the principal that will utilize the qualification credit. No substitutions in attendance may be made for qualifiers and no other trip or compensation will be provided in lieu of attendance. Travel arrangements will be provided by AIG Life Brokerage. Other individual arrangements will be at the qualifier's own expense. AIG Life Brokerage reserves the right to change the dates or site without prior notice. In accordance with the rules and regulations of the Internal Revenue Service, proper income tax reports / documents will be filed / issued.
